**Tarani, Cabernet Sauvignon, Toulouse, France 2007** £14.95  
Soft and fleshy this off dry red is loaded with ripe summer fruit flavours.

**Finca el Picador, Chile 2008** £14.95  
Cool minty cassis fruit with big dash of red cherry and purple plum fruit. Made without the use of oak, this is a juicy mouthful of Chilean sunshine.

**Inspira Reserva, Chile 2006** £16.95  
Loaded with powerful cassis fruit and boasting a lush, opulent texture with a finishing twist of chocolate, this punches well above its price. **Recommended**

## Merlot and Cab/Merlot

**Kintu, Maule Valley, Merlot, Chile 2008** £13.95  
Smooth and easy drinking with ripe plum and red berry flavours

**Domaine Cheval-Blanc Signe, Bordeaux Rouge, France 2008** £18.95  
Silver medal winner at Concors general in Paris 2008  
A classic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Elegant blackcurrant and plum fruit backed up by savoury, juicy tannins and fresh acidity.

**Trentham Estate, Cabernet Merlot, Australia 2006** £22.95  
Tony Murphy, owner and award winning winemaker at Trentham.  
Big, soft and juicy with masses of ripe plum and blackcurrant with a hint of vanilla oak.

## Shiraz & Syrah

**T'air d'Oc Syrah, Domaine Gayda, France 2007** £13.95 £3.65  
Red fruit and hints of spice on the nose. Soft tannins give this medium bodied wine with plenty of structure, a classic Syrah palate. Subtle oak nuances help to smooth the long finish.

**Murphys, Shiraz, Australia 2007** £16.95 £4.50  
Loaded with ripe spicy blackberry fruit backed up by some lovely cream vanilla scented oak. Rich and almost chocolately on the palate this is a very big glassful of wine for your money. You will not be disappointed... **Recommended**

**Marmesa Syrah, California, USA 2006** £24.95  
This is that rare thing – a Californian wine that really over-delivers in value for money terms. Streets ahead of most Californian reds at twice the price.....and then some. **Highly Recommended**

## Pinot Noir

Although traditionally Shiraz is renowned as the accompaniment to Steak we love the marriage between our dry aged beef and a good Pinot.

All our wines are personally selected but the following are our particular favourites.

### Alamos Seleccion, Argentina 2008

£20.95 £5.50

A delicate, floral Pinot with soft cherries and strawberries on the nose followed by fresh, juicy fruit on the smooth, supple palate with a spicy chocolate note from French oak ageing.

### Windy Peak, Pinot Noir Australia 2008

£20.95

A soft and subtle pinot noir with hints of black cherry and spicy oak on the nose. The structure of the wine is balanced by silky, soft tannins, which add texture and length.

### Jean Claude Boisset, Bourgogne, France 2006

£27.95

An ultra modern Burgundy. Dark red with deep purple reflections. Ripe fruit notes in good balance with tannic support evident but subtle.

### Kotuku, New Zealand 2008

£29.95

Pretty floral raspberry and cranberry fruit, smoky oak nuance. Nicely defined red fruits, balanced acidity and linen-textured tannins. An EXCELLENT value for money Pinot

### Navajas Rioja tinto, Rioja, Spain 2007

A blend of Tempranillo and Garnacha aged in new American oak. Loaded with vibrant fresh ripe plum fruit. With a smooth, silky body. It is elegant and sophisticated, leaving a lingering length on the palate

### Navajas Rioja Reserva, Rioja, Spain 2004

Gorgeous bouquet of plum and hedgerow fruits with a hint of vanilla, overlaying the expensive American oak. This wine is rich, well rounded and sumptuous, it shows Rioja at its very best.

### Oveja Negra Touriga, Brazil 2007

Deep ruby red in colour, this blend of Portuguese Touriga and Spanish Tempranillo grape varieties show concentrated cherry and blackberry fruit character with nuances of tobacco and cinnamon. Great with Steak and worth trying!
